Energy Drinks

Summer Uniform & Hot Weather

At ODA we are really excited about the upcoming Summer Term and for the sunny days ahead at school, but would like to remind you about a few important pieces of information.

Sun Protection

Please apply sun cream to your child before school on hot sunny days. We advise that a high factor is applied eg, SPF50. We are able to provide Nivea Kids sun cream SPF50 for children who need to reapply or have outdoor PE in the afternoon. ODA staff can spray the sun cream onto the skin, children will need to rub the cream in themselves. If you do not wish for sun cream to be reapplied to your child at school due to allergies, please can you let us know by sending an email to parents@onedegreeacademy.org. By opting out, ODA staff will be unable to spray sun cream onto your child in hot weather. On hot days we also suggest children wear a sun hat to protect against the sun.

Hay fever

For children who suffer from hay fever and require medication, please follow the medicine protocol for this and complete a form via our school office.

Uniform:

- Trainers are only to be worn on your child's PE day
- Please remember school shoes must be worn on non PE days. Trainers cannot be worn with summer dresses or shorts on non PE days
- Summer dresses and black or grey shorts can be worn in the summer term.
- Black PE shorts may be worn for PE
- Ties are to be worn by Year 1 upwards on non PE days

Summer Uniform Expectations

We are now into the Summer months which means that there are some slight uniform changes. Purple Summer dresses are allowed for girls and dark grey shorts are also allowed for all. Caps are allowed and these need to be purple or plain grey, black or white.
